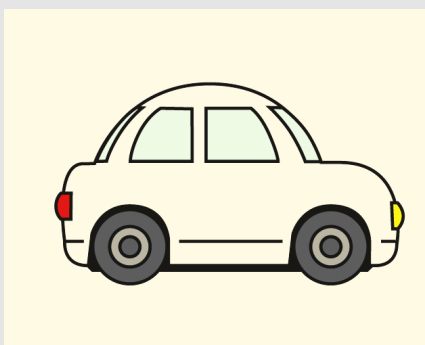
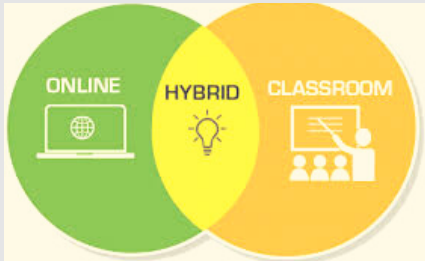

ARE YOU CONSIDERING A HYBRID PLAN LIKE MANY DISTRICTS IN THE STATE?

While we have a hybrid plan in place, we are confident that we can have all students in our school safely while meeting every CDC and RIDOH guideline.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN SOMEONE IN THE BUILDING OR A FAMILY MEMBER TESTS POSITIVE?

The RIDOH is issuing schools a playbook for all schools to follow in the event someone tests positive in our community. We will follow the RIDOH guidance and then alert all community members. We are anticipating the playbook will be publicly available once released.

WHAT TYPE OF PLACEMAT SHOULD MY CHILD BRING IN?

Place mats should be easily wiped down prior to and after lunches. Place mats will be sent home on Fridays for a thorough cleaning.

IF I CHOOSE TO KEEP MY CHILD HOME, WILL ICCRS CONTINUE TO EDUCATE THEM REMOTELY?

We are currently devising a distance learning plan for those families that need to keep their child home, for the children home sick and for those under quarantine orders. We are hoping for both synchronous and asynchronous opportunities that will most likely be provided by our support staff.

WHAT DEVICE DOES THE SCHOOL PREFER FAMILIES TO BUY? WHAT GRADES ARE GOING BYOD?

A touch screen Chromebook is preferred. All device requirements are in the google form and is attached to the most recent newsletter. BYOD is for grades K-8 only.

WILL STUDENTS HAVE PE? WILL STUDENTS IN ALL GRADES GET MOVEMENT BREAKS?

Students will have all CASE classes, including PE. PE will take place outdoors, weather permitting. All students LS-8 will have opportunities built into their days for movement, mask breaks and outdoor time, weather permitting. Middle school will not have recess, but will be given all of the above.

HOW WILL DROP OFF AND PICK UP WORK?

The Crisis Team met to discuss traffic patterns, morning drop off and afternoon pick up procedures. A video illustrating our morning drop off procedures will be sent home in August. We fully understand that taking temps will cause traffic and we hope that all families will be patient and understanding.

WILL THE BUILDINGS HVAC FILTERS BE CHANGED?

Our HVAC system is routinely serviced throughout the year. We are current with all inspections and necessary maintenance.

ARE FACE SHIELDS ALLOWED?

Face shields do not replace a face covering. A shield may be worn in addition to a face covering.

WILL THE SCHOOL BE OFFERING A TUITION REIMBURSEMENT IF WE GO TO DISTANCE LEARNING?

The school is not currently planning to issue reimbursements or tuition breaks due to the necessity of keeping a balanced budget.

HOW WILL EXTENDED CARE WORK?

Extended care will operate in one static pod. Spaces will be limited to those families that require it. We will be unable to adjust the pods by the day, so if you sign up for our extended care, it is for the entire year. There will not be a day to day option. Students will be either in the gymnasium or outside, weather permitting. Face coverings must be worn K-8.

STAFFING AND SUBSTITUTES

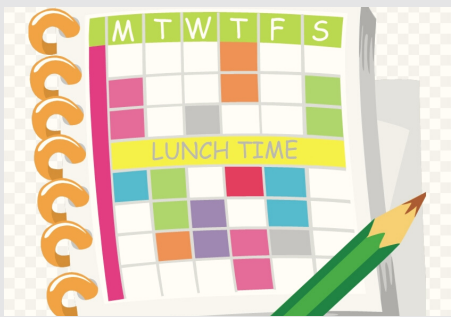
The school has hired a building substitute that will be present daily to fill in, as necessary. In addition, the leadership team and our CASE teachers will fill in as substitutes, when necessary.

WILL OTHER GROUPS BE UTILIZING THE BUILDING AFTER SCHOOL HOURS?

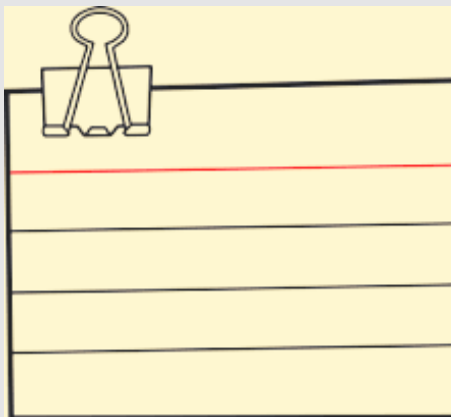
No. The building will only be utilized during the school day by our community.

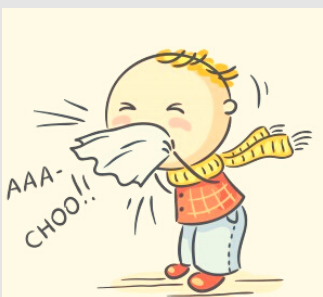
Should we return to distance learning, all students in LS-8 will be offered a continuity of learning. Schedules will be provided prior to the year starting and will include more instructional hours for core content classes, CASE classes and an intervention time or teacher office hours. The schedule is more robust than in the spring.

WHAT WILL RESOURCE AND CRANSTON PUBLIC SCHOOL ASSISTANCE LOOK LIKE?

Each Elementary classroom LS-4 will have a teacher assistant highly capable of supporting our students' needs. Mrs. Rogers and I are currently working on a middle school resource program schedule. We are awaiting information from Cranston Public Schools and fully expect to continue working with them.

CAN EACH CLASSROOM PROVIDE THE APPROPRIATE AMOUNT OF SOCIAL DISTANCING?

Yes. Each classroom allows for either 5-6ft of social distancing between desks. If a classroom was too small to make that accommodation, they were moved to a different location within the building.

HOW WILL STUDENTS GET MASK BREAKS IN THE CLASSROOM?

Since each student's desk is appropriately distanced from each other, students will have masks breaks while sitting at their desks throughout the day. Students will not be required to wear their face coverings while outside.
