Registration Form:

Attached please find the 2017-2018 Winter Sport Basketball Registration Form. Along with the Registration Form, please complete the CAL Code of Conduct and Insurance forms, available on ICCR website, and submit with the registration fee. Registration form and accompanying documents must be completed in its entirety and returned by:

September 21st

Any player forms submitted after that date may not be guaranteed a spot on any team.

Fee Requirements:

The Athletic Committee has tried to keep the cost of participation to a minimum; therefore; registration fee is ***\$100.00 for all Basketball players***

Student Athlete Eligibility:

Students who are in good academic and character standing with the school and community are eligible for participation in school sponsored athletic and extra-curricular activities. Students are expected to honor The Code of Christian Community when participating in these activities.

To be considered a student in “**good standing**” a student must maintain a grade of “70” or above in ELA, Spanish, Math, Science, Religion and Social Studies at the end of each marking period.

A student is considered on “**Academic Probation**” when that student earns between a 65-69 in ELA, Spanish, Math, Science, Religion and Social Studies at the end of each marking period. Students on Academic Probation must comply with probation requirements for participation in any after school activity/athletic program. While on Academic Probation, a student has one trimester to achieve “good standing” status. For that entire trimester the student must attend the department night each week for every class in which he/she does not have a grade of 70 or higher. While on academic probation the student must complete and turn in each homework assignment for that class on time. Students who demonstrate significant and on-going progress while on Academic Probation may be excused from department night but only in advance with the teacher’s written consent notifying the Dean of Student Life and the child’s parents.

A student considered to be on “Behavioral Probation” after formal notification from the Dean of Student Life and/or Principal. The terms of a child’s probation are outlined as determined by Administration and specifically identify eligibility. The school administration makes all decisions based on student/family eligibility.

Students on Behavioral Probation WILL NOT be able to represent the school in any game during the duration of probation.

Team Overviews:

Below is a brief overview of the potential commitment for each sport. Please note that this does not include specifics as actual schedules have not yet been finalized.

Basketball: (Open to Grades 3-8)

TEAM SELECTION & LEAGUE INFORMATION: Before parents choose to allow children to participate in this athletic experience, please note that league rules dictate how we can configure teams. Parents need to be comfortable with the following realities that govern how our school's athletic administration must create teams:

The Catholic Athletic League is divided into two divisions: "Grammar" for grades 7 and 8 and "Junior" for grades 3, 4, 5, and 6. within each division are an A and B class of competition. The classes are supposed to pair up teams against players of similar abilities. Please note that while 7th and 8th grade players will be teamed together, students in grades 4-6 may be on the same team. League restrictions stipulate that if a team is comprised of 50% of students from the highest grade in the division that team must compete in the highest competition class. The challenge for our school is that each year we must work with the number of students who try out and try to the best of our ability to place the students on teams. Our school goal is to create a 3rd-4th grade team and then mixed 5th and 6th grade teams but depending on the number of students who try out, this may not be possible.

Any player forms submitted after that date may not be guaranteed a spot on any team.

Information about Basketball at Immaculate Conception

~ Teams can usually expect to have one game per week scheduled for Saturday mornings or afternoons.

~ Practice schedules should be available after try-out sessions are complete. The expectation can be as follows:

3-6 grade players one time per week; 7-8 grade players two times per week. (Should gym time become available

based on number of students trying out and thus number of teams, we will try to increase practice days for 3-6 grade teams.

~ Games are played at both our school gym and other gyms throughout the state. Players & Parents will be provided

with schedules and gym locations as soon as they are released to ICCR from CAL (Catholic Athletic League). There

are no buses to these games thus it is parent/guardian responsibility to insure player is at the game location as

directed by their coach. If you are unable to provide transportation to or from a game, you must locate alternate

transportation and provide this information in writing to your child's coach.

~ Players participating in either team activity should make commitment a priority and be at all practices and games.

Coaches should be made aware as soon as possible if a player is unable to attend due to illness, travel, family commitment.

PLEASE NOTE: PLAYERS WHO MISS A PRACTICE FOR A REASON OTHER THAN RELATED TO FAITH BASED ACTIVITIES MAY NOT BE GIVEN THE SAME PLAYING TIME DURING A GAME.

Basketball Try-out Information:

There will be two nights of basketball tryouts for each grade level.

	Boys Grades 7-8	7:30-9:00 p.m.
Tuesday, 9/26 & Thursday, 9/28	Girls Grades 4-6	6:00-7:30 p.m.
	Girls Grades 7-8	7:30-9:00 p.m.

Each student/player will be assigned a number as they arrive for tryouts and the tryout team (basketball officials not coaching for ICCR) will be scoring players skills using these numbers. ICCR coaches will be in the gym but not actively involved in player selection. The try-out is closed to parents. However, on the first night of try-outs for each tryout level, there will be short parent meeting. Team announcements will be sent to players via email provided by Friday evening, September 29th.
